  No further monies available Streetscaping project ca. 5-6 yrs. out.
  - b. Gualala Parking Issues: Community parking area discussed pullout

at south end of Gualala for autos & larger vehicles may be possible, Preliminary investigations with an engineer suggested.

- c. CalTrans & County Issues: Council further discussed the potential of being able to retain the paved portion of the bend/jog on Hwy.1 north of Gualala, commonly known as the 'kink'. Utilizing the extra paving as a turnout area for slower traffic traveling north, would be beneficial & an asset to the area. Mills will write letter to, & pursue contact with, CalTrans.
- 11. Treasurer Eckert's Report: Eckert handed out a Draft GMAC Budget to Council Members for review. Uncertainty that County will consistently fund GMAC. CDP income is variable. Administrative Secretary costs form ca. 75% of GMAC expenses. Meeting minutes streamlining and adherence to proposed Ad-Min budgeted dollar amount is necessary to maintain sustainability. Council wishes to demonstrate further responsibility with funds GMAC receives from County. Council action on passing a budget to occur at future meeting. No Action Taken.
