# Special Meeting Summary Minutes DRAFT

### 1. Call to Order

- The meeting was called to order at 2:04 p.m.
- Council members present: Kevin Evans, Robert Juengling, Dave Shpak, Dan Lewis, Donald Hess, Henry Mayer, Melissa Finley.

### 3. Agenda Approval

- The agenda was adopted by unanimous vote.

## 5. Gualala Municipal Advisory Council Bylaws Update

Discussion continued from 1/4/24. Conclude review, discussion, and refinements of revised draft Gualala Municipal Advisory Council (GMAC) Bylaws update prepared by the GMAC Bylaws Committee in response to Mendocino County Policy #51, County Counsel direction, and GMAC discussion on 12/7/23. The meeting objective is to complete discussion of refinements and direct the Bylaws Committee to prepare a final Bylaws update for Council approval and referral to County Counsel.

- Item was introduced by Evans, who deferred to Mayer to describe revisions proposed by the Bylaw Committee.
- The Council discussed Bylaw Committee revisions and revisions offered by Council members. Revisions proposed by the Committee and Council members were refined and accepted by consensus, with one exception. After discussion, a straw poll was taken to revise Section 7.01 Required Majority to allow Bylaws to be amended by simple majority, rather than two-thirds majority of the Council: favored by Evans, Shpak, Lewis, Hess; opposed by Juengling, Mayer, Finley.

• The Council directed the Bylaws Committee to prepare final draft Bylaws, including all revisions and refinements concluded at the special meeting, and submit timely for Council review and discussion at the regular meeting on February 1, 2024.
